Tower Cranes will be manned by two (2) Class A1 operators who will receive \$3.00 per hour over their applicable rate. Tower cranes to include stationary, rall mounted, crawler mounted, hydraulic or friction. For any mode of power, crew to be assigned to crane upon start of erection and will be employed until crane is dismantled and shipped off to job. A Maintenance Engineer (Mechanic) will be employed to assist assembly, jacking of crane and disassembly. One operator is required on any Potain HDT 80 self-erecting mobile tower crane or similar.

Effective 7/1/23, all cranes with manufacturing rating of 100 ton or greater will require an oiler.
